WHERE:

Abidjan lies on the Ébrié Lagoon, on some peninsulas and converging islands linked by bridges. With the construction of a new pier in 1931, the city boomed and was designated, a few years later, the capital of the French colony. The inauguration of the Vridi canal led to important growth of the port, with its connection to the sea. In 1983, Yamoussoukro became the national capital but most government offices and foreign embassies remained in Abidjan.
